Restoration Projects

A series of renovation projects have been ongoing both inside and outside the hall to make it as welcoming and accessible as possible to all visitors. The **Lions Foundation** project above includes internal painting and floor restoration. HRP completed the painting and Tony Judd will finish restoring the floor in May.



Lottery Grants Board supported us last year by funding our accessibility project which included, water filtration and internet installation. This year we were awarded a grant for a fencing project. This will help keep children and families safe. Coastline Fencing Ltd are working with the council to complete this project.


Local Initiatives & Opportunities
